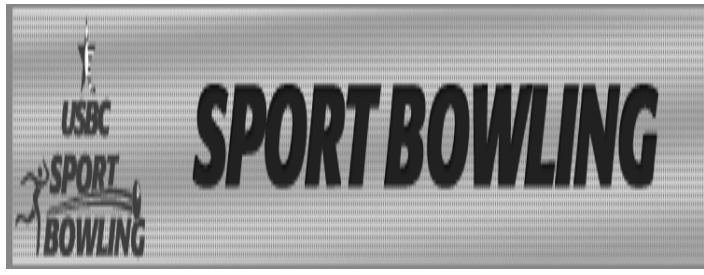

Eligibility: Open to all USBC-Certified youth, twelve years old and up (based on August 1, 2009). Pre-registration is encouraged, contact Ty Davidson via email for registration. Registration fee of \$30.00 due prior to competition. This fee includes a shirt and card upgrade. *This is a SPORT-Jr. GOLD certified league. Participants that will age out prior to 2011 will only pay a \$10.00 sport card upgrade fee. Current Jr. Gold card members will have no registration fee. All bowlers are required to pay Ohio and Dayton USBC dues to participate in this league.*

Schedule: The league will bowl on Wednesdays at 7:00 pm (check-in time 6:30 pm) for 12 weeks beginning May 5th and concluding on July 28, 2010. Then entire house schedule is posted on front side of flyer.

Sport Compliant: The league will participate on PBA Sport **CERTIFIED** conditions. Each pattern will be scheduled in advance to allow athletes to research each pattern prior to competition. This league will pay for the sport card for each participant.

Dress Code: The shirt provided is intended for competition each week. Shorts and jeans are permitted for this league, hats/head covers are not permitted. League management will determine if any attire is deemed inappropriate.

Format/Scoring: This is a singles tournament-format league. Each week, all bowlers will bowl a three (3) game qualifying round. The top 16 bowlers (based on 32 or more entries), will advance to a bracketed, single game elimination rounds until a weekly champion is determined. Weekly top qualifying two females will round out the top 16.

Cost: The cost per bowler per week is \$16.00. Breakdown: \$9.00 lineage, ***\$6.00 for awards*** and \$1.00 to Wright State Collegiate Bowling in lieu of secretary fees.

Handicap: Handicap will be based on 80% of 200. Maximum handicap per bowler per game: 32 pins (160 average). Handicap based on scores rolled in this league from the 1st week of participation.

Attendance: There is no pre-bowling or post-bowling. Substitutes are allowed to bowl for a regular for only three (3) weeks and must have a book average for the last year that is lower than the regular's book average. A minimum of (8) weeks participation is required to be eligible to compete in the championship round.

Points: Every bowler will earn points each of the Twelve (12) weeks in which the bowler participates. Points will not be earned at the end-of-season Championship Tournament (week 13). Points will be earned each week based on the following formula:

Bowlers will earn one (1) point for every bowler who finishes below the bowler in the ***Qualifying Round***. Points based on placement and performance are earned every week in which you bowl. The more weeks you bowl, the more points you earn. End of season 1, 2 & 3 place point leaders will receive awards.

Championship: This league will conduct an end of season championship Tournament July 28, 2010 in which all bowlers who bowled in this league no fewer than (8) weeks, may participate. Championship round does not count toward the required eight weeks for qualification. Format: The end-of-season Championship Tournament will consist of a three (3) game qualifying round which will advance the top 17 bowlers along with each week's champion (12), plus the top (3) point leaders, total of 32. If any of these bowlers qualified twice during the league, the vacancies will be filled from the qualifying field. The Championship bracket will be single game elimination format.

Awards: Smart money scholarship based on number of players, (\$5,218 for 2009). End of season awards for: point leader 1st, 2nd & 3rd; High average / game / series both boy & girl (HDGP & SCRATCH); Tournament Champion & runner-up. League points leader for boys and girls will each receive a Jr. Gold entry along with tournament Champ.

Compliance: In the event of a dispute not specifically covered by our league rules, bowlers agree, by their voluntary participation in the league, the authority of league management will adjudicate all disputes, (subject to USBC rules) and what is deemed to be in the best interest of this league.
